TRANS PORT ILFORD STATION

ELIZABETH LINE SERVICES FROM ILFORD STATION

New Class 345 trains are in use between Shenfield and Liverpool Street.



The majority are currently seven-car long, with an upgrade programme due in the autumn of 2021 to increase these trains to nine-car (which is the full length of train for Elizabeth line services when it opens in the first half of 2022). When the full route opens, passengers will be able to travel through central London without having to change trains.

COM MU NITY HIGH ROAD

The High Road transformation is due for completion at the end of November, with 80% of the works already completed. 5,200sqm of granite has been laid,



8 new trees planted, 5 new flowerbeds installed, 4 new planters, 6 new bins and 20 new benches. Future features include play areas and drinking fountains.
